GET YOUR WORK EXHIBITED AT THE UNIVERSITY GALLERY IN SPLIT

The University of Split, a member of the European University of the Seas (SEA-EU) alliance, invites professional artists from Cádiz (Spain), Brest (France), Kiel (Germany), Malta (Malta) and Gdansk (Poland) to present at a juried group exhibition which will take place at the University Gallery in Split, Croatia, 31st May - 10th June 2022. Applications can be submitted until April, 15th, and the selection will be announced on April 22nd, 2022.

WHO CAN APPLY?

The call is intended for visual artists from the cities of the SEA-EU alliance: Cádiz, Brest, Kiel, Malta and Gdansk.





Please note that the artists <u>do not</u> have to be employees of the SEA-EU universities.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

2D artworks are accepted (paintings, drawings, original prints and photography). The theme is open and the **subject matter is the choice of the artist.** The maximum size of each artwork is 1,5 m x 1,5 m. Entries must be original works created by the submitting artist.

The application must include:

- CV
- Portfolio or a link to the artist's website
- Up to five works (for each work please provide a highquality image, artists statement, technical details /dimensions and medium/, and label text)
- Remarks regarding special technical requirements for the set-up of the submitted works.

Application deadline: April, 15th, 2022

SELECTION PROCEDURE

All submitted works will be judged by a jury composed of esteemed professors from the Arts Academy in Split. Five artists will be selected for the exhibition.

The selection will be announced on April 22nd, 2022.

The SEA-EU Office at the University of Split will contact the selected artists and guide them through the process of obtaining a grant for their travel to Split.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SELECTED ARTISTS

The selected artists will have to apply for a travel and subsistence grant (till the end of April).

They will have to arrive at Split two days before the exhibition and help with the installation of their works. They will also have to be present at the opening reception.

In addition, the artists will have to take part in an artist talk / roundtable discussion.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SPLIT

The University of Split will assist the selected artists in obtaining funding for their travel to Split, provide them with information on how to find the accommodation.

The University Gallery will support artists by providing exhibition venue and technical assistance for the installation of the works. The Gallery will promote the event, produce a printed catalogue of the exhibition, as well as photo-documentation.


Gallery floor plan, dimensions and photographs
