The Electric Alley is a rock band who formed in Cadiz (Spain) at the end of 2012. Drinking the essence of the music from the 70's, they started to compose songs for their first album "Backward States of Society" which won high accolades and reviews from the national press and 5 of their songs were featured on the F1 Channel produced by MOVISTAR TV, the song "No Control" was the lead track of the Formula 1 World Championship in each of its editions during 2014 and 2015.

In 2015, they dove into composing their 2nd album, "Get Electrified!", which allowed them to take another step forward in their journey, thanks to the superior quality of the songs and the maturity of the band.

The song "A Lonely Sun Story" was the soundtrack of the short fiction film, Homonymous. Which was nominated for the Royal Academy of Spanish Cinema Goya Awards and the ASECAN Awards of Andalusian Cinema in 2015 and 2016 respectively.

"Get Electrified!" is considered one of the best albums of their genre in 2015 by the specialised Spanish media (Ruta 66, This Is Rock, Metalcry.com). The "Get Electrified!" tour gave the band the opportunity to perform more than 50 shows in Spain, including big festivals such as, Z! Live and Calella Rock Fest, also festivals in France (Ralsmes Fest, alongside bands like The Answer and Diamond Head) and in the U.K.

The "Get Electrified!" Tour continued to perform throughout Spain while expanding their wings through Europe (France, Holland, Belgium, Germany, Switzerland and Slovakia) in December 2017 via the help of Teenage Head Music. The band began to sow their seeds of rock n roll with great success and as they left their mark in each city, this allowed the seeds to grow fruitfully.

In 2018, the band went into the studio to prepare their new LP, "Turning Wheels" which is a new turn in their career and it shows off their essence in the most classic way, while adding splashes of Soul, Blues, Rock n Roll and Dance to some of their compositions, without neglecting the high revolution of hard rock, which they are famous for.

Rock is more alive than ever when The Electric Alley take to the stage, as the formation of four musicians evoke the energy and passion that every music lover looks for when watching a concert, with influences from Led Zepelin or The Black Crowes to Rival Sons, Blackberry Smoke or Mr. Big.

After more than 100 shows around Europe and counting, the band is preparing their fourth LP that will be produced by Movistar, and a new tour by the end of 2022

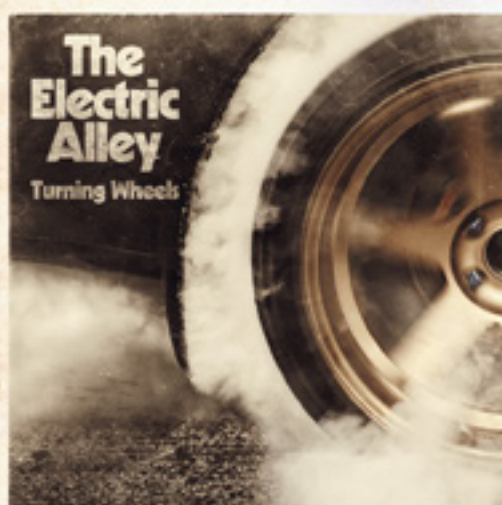
